YOUNG CARE LEAVERS

We have designed a Tenancy Ready Course for young care leavers in partnership with BMBC Youth Participation service and their Advocacy & Participation officers.

The course has so far included sessions with the Assessment Team Leader to provide the young people with the right information about the lettings process and a Tenants First Housing Coach who spoke to them about budgeting, finances and support available to them. This month a Gas Compliance Officer and Electrical Compliance Inspector came along to talk to them about gas safety, electrical trip boxes and how to reset them and looked at water supply and stop tap locations in case of a leak.

DAMP AND MOULD TRAINING COURSE

We held another 2 damp and mould training sessions for tenants in Gateway Plaza this month. The courses have developed in partnership with Efficiency North and are accredited by Northern Open College Network. The aim of the course is to share tips on how to spot, help prevent, treat and report signs of damp, mould and condensation in your home. The session is broken down into 2 sections, a presentation about our STAR campaign, you can find out more about this on our website and an accredited online learning section. We had 6 tenants come into the offices this month to complete the training and 3 more completed it online.

EMPTY PROPERTY SPOT CHECKS

In January we completed 5 empty property spot checks in areas:

- Great Houghton
- Goldthorpe
- Mapplewell
- Hoyland

2 SEAP assessors came with us to the properties to carry out the spot checks, making sure empty properties are up to the void standard. All properties passed the inspections and any issues were raised with the relevant teams.

This month the Check it Challengers completed two projects. They looked at the letters that will be going out to tenants on this years rent increase and gave us their views on what information should be included to make sure its tenant friendly.

They also looked at the information inserts that come with letters the Lettings Team send out . They were asked for their thoughts on whether they were helpful and what else we could include to make sure tenants get all information they need.
